- 3. Educate ourselves and our community by providing articles or other information surrounding inclusion, equity and justice within the food systems.
- 4. Collaborate with a local partner organization to educate our board, members and followers on issues of racial injustices in a program in winter 2021.
- 5. Explore land use policies within Wallowa County and advocate in cooperation with Oregon Community Food System Network to support inclusion, equity and justice within those policies.
- 6. Produce Slow Food Wallowas marketing products (such as newsletter issue, a bookmark or other material) with a statement of our commitment to an antiracist food system for distribution through our publicity and networks.
